Family Housing

San Veron Park was Mid-Peninsula Housing Coalition's first development. Financed under HUD Section 236, this 32-unit family development was completed in 1971.

San Veron Park is an attractive, low-density development with extensive lawn areas, a recreation room, plus two play areas for children. San Veron Park is next door to a park.

San Veron consists of one- and two-story townhouses and adjoins a neighborhood of single-family homes. There are 10 two-bedroom units, 15 three-bedroom units, and seven four-bedroom units.

Each unit has its own patio and there are laundry facilities on site.

San Veron was presented with the 1971 City of Mountain View Mayor's Award for creating an outstanding residential environment through the use of color, materials and form, thereby making this unique affordable family development an architectural as well as a social asset to the community.
