Kottinger Gardens - Phase 1 is the first phase of the redevelopment of Kottinger Place and Pleasanton Gardens, two existing affordable housing properties for seniors that will become one integrated affordable housing community conveniently located near bus lines, parks, and downtown amenities. Once completed, Kottinger Gardens will provide 185 new affordable rental apartments, more than double the original amount. Completed in 2017, Phase 1 provides 131 new affordable apartment homes for existing Kottinger Place and Pleasanton Gardens residents, and also

welcomed new senior residents.

Kottinger Gardens is the result of thoughtful planning by the City of Pleasanton and the Kottinger Place Redevelopment Task Force. The Task Force and the City recognized the need for additional senior homes and planned for a way to accomplish this while maintaining the existing character
