Redwood Court was Redwood City's first subsudized family housing community. Centrally located near shopping centers, major thoroughfares

and public transportation, Redwood Court provides 27 homes for families. The community was built by MidPen in 1983 and later rehabilitated in 2004.

As part of its renovations, Redwood Court received new siding and paint, and improvements to the apartments' private balconies and entrances. Energy-efficient upgrades were
