## SARATOGA COURT SENIOR HOUSING

Saratoga Court was originally built in 1978 and acquired by MidPen Housing in 1983. A senior community of 20 garden apartments arranged around a

cental courtyard, Saratoga Court is adjacent to two churches, public transportation and locateed within a half-block of shopping centers.

Four-plexs surround community gardens and landscaped areas. Each apartment has a private entrance with sliding glass doors, enclosed by a four-foot fence and rear porch. There is also an office
