Built through a partnership between the Roman Catholic Diocese of San Jose, Holy Family Affordable Housing, Inc. and MidPen Housing, **Santa Familia** provides affordable housing for 79 families and senior residents.

Santa Familia consists of garden apartments arranged around a spacious courtyard. At the center of the community, there is a play area and landscaped grounds. A computer lab provides a space for onsite resident programs, such as technology training and after school tutoring.



In 2003, Santa Familia was selected

as a semi-finalist for the Affordable Housing, Property and Asset Management award by the MetLife Foundation Awards for Excellence.
