1500 Capitola Road Housing is the result of a partnership between MidPen Housing, Santa Cruz Community Health Centers, and Dientes Community Dental Care to provide affordable housing and healthcare services to the Live Oak area of Santa Cruz County. The affordable housing community marks the final phase of a campus that co-locates affordable housing with affordable healthcare services, the first of its

kind in Santa Cruz County. Construction on 1500 Capitola Road Housing began in March 2022 and will welcome 57 households in fall 2023.

The community will serve families and households with supportive housing needs, including individuals who have experienced homelessness.
