Re: Senate Bill (SB) 440 – Support

Dear Senator Skinner,

MidPen Housing Corporation is proud to support your bill, SB 440, which will empower local governments to join forces to create regional housing finance agencies to address the unique affordable housing needs in their communities. These agencies will be able to generate revenue for the construction, preservation, and management of affordable and missing middle housing in their region.

MidPen Housing is one of the nation's leading nonprofit developers, owners and managers of high-quality affordable housing and onsite resident services. Since MidPen was founded in 1970, we have developed over 100 communities and 8,000 homes for low-income families, seniors and those with supportive housing needs throughout Northern California.

Californians are struggling with the direct impacts of a decade's long, increasingly severe housing crisis. The cumulative effects of years of inadequate housing construction has resulted in a shortage of 3.5 million homes. While the state has increased funding for affordable housing and policymakers have passed numerous reforms to expedite construction, it is clear there is still more to be done.

One of the areas that California must find innovative solutions for, is raising funds for housing construction and preservation. Housing experts estimate that California will need to spend \$8.1 billion annually for 12 years to dig itself out of its homelessness crisis. A new strategy that is already proving useful for bridging the funding gap is the creation of regional housing finance agencies, which are powerful tools that are capable of raising billions to develop unique, regional housing solutions tailored for the communities they serve.

SB 440 will maximize the ability of the state to take advantage of this innovative funding model for housing by allowing all regions in California to create their own housing finance agency without needing to come to the legislature first.
