Shirley Chisholm Village is MidPen's first development in San Francisco, and will provide 135 affordable rental apartments with preference for San Francisco Unified School District educators and district employees. It is the first educator housing community for the City and County of San Francisco and the San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD). It is one of

only a handful of educator housing developments in the state.

Shirley Chisholm Village is named for Shirley Chisholm, the first black woman elected to US Congress and the first woman to run for the Democratic Party's presidential nomination. **Before** becoming
