**Colibri Commons** (formerly known as 965 Weeks Street) will serve a broad range of the community's housing needs, with rents affordable to people earning between 30% and 60% of Area Median Income (in 2023, \$39,150-\$147,180 depending on family size) and a unit mix of studios up to four bedrooms. Colibri Commons will help meet the housing needs of the East Palo Alto community and bring to life a long-vacant lot and the underutilized Rail Spur walking path.

EPACANDO and MidPen's joint partnership will create high-quality, long-term, 100% affordable homes for a diverse range of household incomes and household sizes. Colibri Commons is anticipated to open in Summer 2025.
