Bienestar Plaza is the result of a partnership between MidPen Housing, Santa Cruz Community Health Centers, and Dientes Community Dental Care to provide affordable housing and healthcare services to the Live Oak area of Santa Cruz County.

The affordable housing community marks the final phase of a campus that co-locates affordable housing with affordable healthcare services, the first of its kind in Santa Cruz County.

The community serves families and households with supportive housing needs, including individuals who have experienced homelessness.

All residents have access to services onsite, as well as case management for those with supportive housing needs.
