414 Petaluma is accepting applications for **18 apartments available for eligible agricultural or farmworker households.** All available units are designated for agricultural or farmworker families. Agricultural or farmworker families are defined as: a household consisting of at least one person who earns or earned, prior to retirement or disability, a substantial portion of his or her income from farmworker employment. *Minimum Required Income is 2X Monthly Rent.
