Fair Haven Commons is the culmination of several years of close work between MidPen Housing, the City of Fairfield, the Fairfield Housing Authority and Solano County to develop an underutilized, vacant lot into supportive and family housing for those most in need. including individuals and families who are extremely low income. The community provides 72 affordable homes for families, including 44 units with set-aside preference for households who are at-risk or experiencing homelessness, and other supportive housing needs.

Residents at Fair Haven Commons enjoy several amenities, including a community building with a multi-purpose room and kitchen, an activities room, and outdoor recreation areas including picnic tables and BBQ. The community is located close to shopping, public transportation, and a public park.
