

MOSAIC GARDEN AT FRIENDLY ACRES

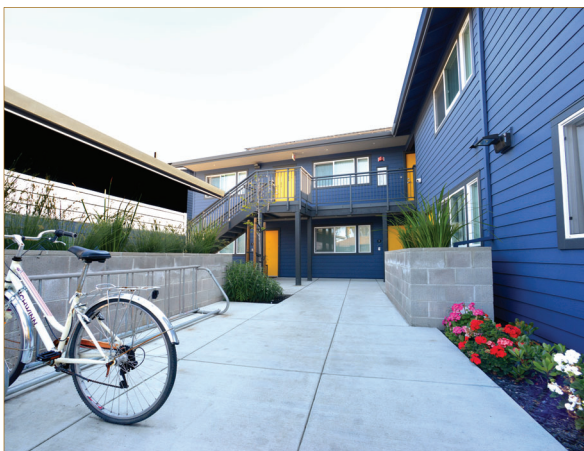

Mosaic Garden at Friendly Acres is the result of a long-standing partnership between the County of San Mateo and MidPen Housing to preserve affordable housing and prevent displacement of residents in Redwood City. Originally constructed in the early 1960s, MidPen acquired the property in 2016 in order to ensure affordability in the long-run. In 2018, Mosaic Garden at Friendly Acres underwent a major rehabilitation and renovation, which included updated amenities for resident apartments and structural and aesthetic improvements to the buildings' façade. All residents were temporarily relocated during construction, and returned in late 2019, achieving 100% occupancy by December of that year.
