The result of a visionary partnership between the City of Redwood City, County of San Mateo, community stakeholders, and MidPen Housing, **Arroyo Green Apartments** provides 117 affordable homes for seniors and a child care center below, set along a creekside trail in the heart of downtown Redwood City. The community began construction in April 2019 and welcomed residents spring 2021.

Arroyo Green helps address the need for affordable housing for a growing population of seniors. The design supports the goal of healthy living, allowing seniors to age in place and continue to



live active and enriched lives. Residents enjoy onsite amenities such as an open air rooftop courtyard with community gardening planters, barbecue, and seating. Indoors, there is a community room, computer lab, a game room and library, a fitness room, and two laundry rooms.

Development of Arroyo Green also includes a creekside trail that is open to the public. The ground-floor child care center includes an outdoor playground, and programming is operated by Footsteps, a non-profit child care provider.

Through a network of service providers, MidPen Services coordinates onsite programs for senior residents.
