Brooklyn Basin is a new mixed-use, mixed-income district along Oakland's waterfront, that will feature 3,100 new homes, creative retail, parks, and open spaces along 64 acres, and includes **Paseo Estero**, which provides 101 deeply affordable rental apartments for families. The result of an innovative and highly collaborative public/private partnership, what was once an underutilized and mostly industrial site, is being

transformed into a highly livable, walkable, accessible and beautifully-designed district to benefit generations to come. The City of Oakland and Signature Development Group, Brooklyn Basin's master developer, selected MidPen to be the district's affordable housing partner in 2015.
