courtyard, secure bicycle storage, in-unit laundry, and property management and resident services offices.

Carefully phased to avoid displacement of current residents, Midway Village, in its entirety, will replace 150 aging and outdated units with 555 new and sustainable apartment homes thus, transforming and revitalizing
