## **OAK GARDENS**

SUPPORTIVE HOUSING FOR VETERANS

Menlo Park, CA





Located on an infill site directly on the VA Palo Alto Healthcare System Campus in Menlo Park, **Oak Gardens** is a 100% permanent supportive housing community providing 62 homes (including 2 manager's units) for Veterans and their families. Of the 62 apartment homes, 55 will have a preference for households experiencing homelessness, and of the 55 apartments, six will be set aside for chronically homeless households.

Given its location on the VA Palo Alto Healthcare System Campus, Oak Gardens provides a unique opportunity to bridge health and housing. Residents will have direct access to services and programs offered by the VA, making this site ideal for this veteran community. Oak Gardens is surrounded by an abundance of amenities, including public transportation, neighborhood-serving

retail and markets, open space and recreation.

Oak Gardens is made possible through the VA's Enhanced Use Lease Program (EUL) which allows the VA to lease out underutilized VA land for the purpose of developing supportive housing for Veterans.
