Saratoga Court was originally built in 1978 and acquired by MidPen Housing in 1983. A community for seniors and individuals with disabilities, Saratoga Court consists of 20 garden apartments arranged in fourplexes around a central courtyard with community gardens and landscaped areas. The property is adjacent to two churches, public transportation and located within a half-block of shopping centers.

Each apartment has a private entrance with sliding glass doors, enclosed by a four-foot fence and rear porch. There is also an office and laundry center in a separate building. Residents of Saratoga Court enjoy access to community activities, onsite resident services, and connections to community resources.
