Jessie Street Terrace reflects the long-term commitment and investment MidPen has in its portfolio. A redevelopment of MidPen's Jessie Street Apartments, Jessie Street Terrace provides 50 affordable apartments and supportive services for individuals experiencing homelessness, including veterans.

Jessie Street Terrace is a result of innovative planning and collaboration between MidPen Housing, the Palo Alto VA, the County of Santa Cruz Health Services Agency, and the California Department of Housing and Community Development.

With California state laws allowing for increased density and a California Housing Accelerator award, the vision to increase the community's households by 36 units— from 14 to 50— became a reality.

Residents of Jessie Street Terrace receive a suite of services, programs, and case management tailored to individual needs. MidPen partnered with the Santa Cruz County Health Services Agency's Behavioral Health unit and the Palo Alto VA for wraparound services that allow residents to remain successfully housed.

Construction began in April 2023 and welcomed residents starting early 2025.
